CERTIFICATE/DIPLOMA IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PRACTICE

The NUI Diploma in Community Development Practice is a one-year (part time) course which is assessed and certified by the National University of Ireland Galway.

The Diploma in Community Development Practice has been designed to enable Community Activists (volunteers and paid staff in the community / voluntary sector) to develop the knowledge, understanding and essential practical skills and experience required to provide leadership within this field.

Mode of Study: Blended Learning - practical exercises, reading materials, coursework and group work. Also pulls on the group's experiences of working /volunteering in the sector. Locations TBC.

One off cost of £150 per person to cover administration fees, if you are unwaged then we can talk to you about how we can support you to meet this payment.



Places are limited to 25 students.

End Date 1st June 2022.

- 90% attendance is required for successful graduation from the course.
- Must be 21 years old by 1st January 2021.
- Must be willing to travel to Galway for graduation.
